Control pests & the spread of disease to animals, plants, or the environment

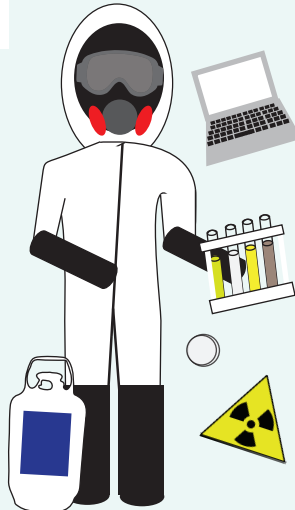
Remove & destroy pests or arrange for them to be destroyed

JOB OVERVIEW

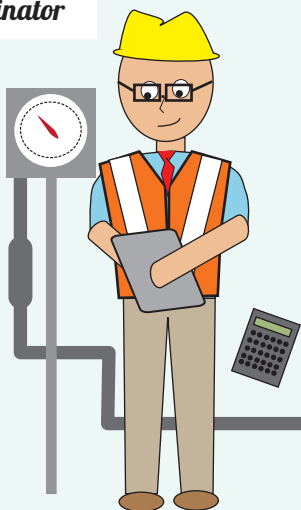
Be responsible for the policy, procedures & measurement of occupational health & safety in the workplace

Pressure Washer Operator

JOB OVERVIEW

Operate power washer to remove dirt, debris, waste & staining within animal production facilities & animal transportation vehicles

Use degreasers or removal chemicals when needed/requested

Clean up rubble, debris & other waste from area being washed

Maintain established schedule & work to improve schedule efficiency

Sanitation Coordinator

JOB OVERVIEW

Direct, coordinate & maintain the cleanliness of an assigned production area; prevent unsanitary situations

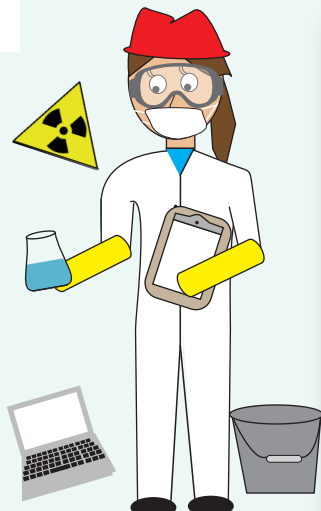
Facilitate corrective actions related to pest prevention & sanitation

Perform zonal inspections weekly to cover the entire facility searching for opportunities pertaining to sanitation & sanitary design

Provide initial & annual training on proper sanitation practices

High school diploma or Associate's degree in business operations, food safety, or agricultural business

Food processing facilities including vegetables, meat, dairy & dry packaged goods

Storage & Hygiene Coordinator

JOB OVERVIEW

Implement the scheduling & treatment or fumigation of grain & other products

Inspect properties, identify problems, determine treatments & provide estimates of costs for replacement

Mix chemicals to specified concentrations & confirm usage on treatment of raw materials

Fumigate storage spaces, houses or office furnishings & clothing

Water Treatment Technician

JOB OVERVIEW

Perform daily monitoring of agricultural plant functions, specifically their waste water treatment

Execute process sampling to accurately gauge & monitor levels

Assist in interpreting & applying technical regulatory requirements on production operations

Promptly troubleshoot process, instrumentation, data & mechanical problems
